Parents of Young Children

We are so glad you are here, and that you brought your children with you! Thank you! A few suggestions for your worship experience:

Relax! God put the wiggle in children; don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. It can be helpful to sit toward the front where it is easier for children to see and hear. Sing hymns loudly, pray, and voice the responses with enthusiasm. Children learn behavior by copying you. If you are excited about God, they will be too!

Teach children some of the basic prayers; being able to join in with the prayers helps them feel they are contributing, too. Also, it can be helpful to explain to your child what is happening during the service.

So that the children will become familiar with the rhythm of worship, we invite them to the "Prayground" in the side alcove of the sanctuary immediately following Children's Moment. Children will participate in age-appropriate activities that connect to the bible verses and message each week. Our goal is to keep the children engaged until the end of the sermon. However, children younger than 4 may have difficulty remaining in the sanctuary for the extended period of time. If necessary, younger children may be taken to the nursery before the sermon begins. Please attend worship often! Children like and need routines where they can participate.

To those who are sitting near worshiping parents and children:

A smile of encouragement is always welcome to parents with small, active children! Jesus welcomed the little children, and so do we. Whether talking, crying, laughing, or singing, the sounds of children in worship are joyful songs of praise.

<u>6 Weeks-Pre-K</u> meet in the nursery. Nursery is extended through service. All nursery staff are First Aid and CPR certified, have undergone a background check and complete additional child care and development training annually. Nursery care begins at 9:20am.

Gospel Reading group meets in the Parlor to discuss the Gospel reading of the week.

<u>Pre-K—5th Grade</u> meet in The Gathering Place to learn the New Testament and how to connect the teachings of God to their everyday lives.

<u>Saints Under Construction</u> meet in The Gathering Place using the Presbyterian curriculum, "The Present Word", to engage in the opportunity to connect your faith with the world around you.

<u>The Explorers</u> meet in the Conference Room to study the Bible book-by-book using different translations that help the lively and thought provoking discussions.
