





March Mission Updates & Opportunities

Missions during the COVID 19 Outbreak- As you can imagine, many of the typical Missions that we participate in have been curtailed due to social distancing requirements in place to mitigate transmission of the virus. We have adapted to this and have changed the focus of our mission work to respond to needs arising from our current challenges. We have two initiatives now and are developing others.

- Sewing masks for medical staff and first responders- As you have all seen on the news, there is a critical, national shortage of personal protective equipment for medical staff and first responders.
 We have a dedicated group, led by Kay Craig, who have taken it upon themselves to sew masks to protect the people that take care of us. If you would like to help, please contact Kay Craig.
- <u>Letters & Cards for medical staff and first responders-</u> These people work a lot of hours and are
 under an incredible amount of stress between patient concerns, long works hours, and concerns
 for their own families. While we can't do a lot about these things, we can offer written

SBPC Hot Meals on Weekends – The current COVID-19 restrictions have made this service opportunity possibly more important than ever. These types of services have been declared "essential services" by the county, so we have been able to continue delivering meals. The 4th Saturday of each month we look for individuals to deliver meals to shut-ins. We have 2 routes with about 14 people on each route, so we usually need a total of 4 volunteers each month. Please contact Lu Taylor if you are interested in volunteering to deliver meals one month. The Saturday for this month will be April 25.

You Are Invited to be a Pen Pal












Dear Spring Branch Presbyterian Church and Academy Families,

As an educator I know how important it is to be prepared to address the concerns, misunderstandings, and possible fears of children when something scary is happening around them. The current health concerns are confusing and frightening to me, and I'm an adult!

I am hoping your schools have reached out to you with suggestions and a framework for *listening*, responding appropriately, and having a conversation with your children in age appropriate ways about COVID 19. I'm sure they have heard things at school from their peers. Some of what they may have heard may not be accurate.

If you do not currently have children or grandchildren, you may likely be around them at some point. And YOU might be one of those trusted adults in our children's lives. So they might come to you with their concerns.

Below are several resources to help you both listen and respond to your child's questions; as well as current information. And as you know as parents, grandparents, and teachers those kid questions can come out at the most random and unexpected times! Gotta love kids!

We are encouraged to practice social distancing. And we can still interact and care for each other when we might be out and about with a smile, a wave, and a thank you to those who are serving us in some capacity. Keep in touch with family members and neighbors. Right now we are all each others' neighbors because how we care for ourselves effects the health of others.

And remember these simple conversation between a mother and her son;

When I was a child and would see scary things on the news, my mother would say to me, "Look for the helpers. You will always find people who are helping."
