He graduated from Waltrip High School in Houston in 1969, the University of Houston in 1973, Austin Presbyterian Seminary with a Master of Divinity in 1977, and the Doctor of Ministry in 1996. Jim and Anne were married in the Austin Seminary Chapel on August 21, 1976. Anne is a Professor of Pediatrics and Medical Ethics at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston. She is also the Assistant Dean for Interprofessional Education. They are the parents of two children, Andrew (est.1983) and Abbey (est. 1989).
