



INVITATION TO CONFESSION

Leader: Jesus says in today's gospel lesson, that "Now the Son of Man is glorified." If we did not know what had gone before, we could assume that the 'now' referred to some glorious achievement or victory. The 'now', however, refers to the movement of Jesus towards the cross following Judas' departure into the night. Now - God's love would be shown to be stronger than evil - sins would be forgiven - for the time of salvation is near. Through his obedience even to death - Jesus glorifies God. Glory is therefore inextricably linked to sacrificial love.

CONFESSION OF SIN (responsive)

Leader: Gracious and loving God, as we reflect on the wonder and glory of your being, and the depth of your love for us, we are conscious of our failure to learn from you and from the sacrificial love of Jesus. So often our understanding of glory is linked with prestige and power and position. Jesus' understanding of glory was linked to a love that was prepared to go to the uttermost limits of love. Forgive us when selfish pursuit of glory takes precedence over Jesus' command to love one another as he has loved us.
 People: Forgive us when we put economic, racial, social or other boundaries on our love.
