Greetings, members and friends of SBPC,

What a strange and exciting time we are living in! Things which have been put on hold are now coming back on line. For most of us, that means programs or other cherished activities, and that is certainly true. For others it means relationships. And we are certainly now able to be in person again, finally, with some from whom we have been physically separated. This is great.

Why shouldn't things come back to life? After all, this is the Easter season! On that first Resurrection morning, there were no filled pews. No one dressed up nicely. There were no egg hunts or nice dinners planned. Nothing... except to prepare a dead body. How different things are now!

The Easter season is 50 days long, which corresponds with the time between Passover and Pentecost, the Jewish feast marking the barley harvest. It was on that first Pentecost after Jesus rose from the dead that the church was truly born, when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the church. That is when the growth truly began. Can we recapture this image today? Let me be clear: The church at Pentecost should be larger numerically than the church at Easter. What if the church truly understood this fundamental truth? What if our world saw the proof of the resurrection during these 50 days in our community?

I believe it can happen. I am praying it will happen! I want to rejoice with you when it does.

As things come back to life, let's make sure our church is at the top of the list!


