#### From the desk of Pastor Mark...

My dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

To paraphrase the old adage: "Humans plan; God laughs."

We all had a healthy dose of this when the big storm hit our area last week. Trees were uprooted, branches were snapped off and soared hundreds of feet, houses were damaged, downtown buildings had windows shattered, and electricity became something we all remembered we take for granted! It's a humbling, exhausting, ridiculous experience!

But, of course, there is a great lesson in all this!

No matter how much "control" we think we have over our world and all that is in it, it doesn't take much to remind us of how helpless we truly are. Take away our electricity, take away our Internet connection (even for a little while), take away our usual routes when we drive around, or take away a simple morning cup of coffee – and life becomes something of a struggle.

So... since I know all of you have access to a printed Bible, I invite you to read and ponder these:

- **Isaiah 4:6** It will be a shelter and shade from the heat of the day, and a refuge and hiding place from the storm and rain.
- **Luke 8:23-25** As they sailed, he fell asleep. A squall came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped, and they were in great danger. The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" He got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waters; the storm subsided, and all was calm. "Where is your faith?" he asked his disciples. In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."
- **Psalm 107:29** He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed.
- **Ecclesiastes 7:13-14** When times are good, be happy; but when times are bad, consider this: God has made the one as well as the other. Therefore, no one can discover anything about their future.
- **Psalm 27:5** For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent and set me high upon a rock.

Remember at all times – especially when we have our lives disrupted by unexpected happenings – our God is mightier than anything that can happen. Disasters can come at any time (and probably will), but we will be rewarded by having steadfast faith. Amen!



The "Mission for the Month" in June is NewSpring. NewSpring is a returning benevolence to our church. We have partnered with NewSpring in the past to help host Christmas in the Park, and provide financial support for their art programs for children in Spring Branch. NewSpring's mission has expanded to use art and technology to promote entrepreneurship and career exploration.

NewSpring also partners with students within Spring Branch ISD at Northbrook High School through the Flight 25 program. The Flight 25 program brings in a variety of speakers from across different industries to expose students to different career paths to help them complete their high school education. Graduates of the program are also eligible to receive scholarships for college or vocational programs. Our church will be partnering with NewSpring during VBS this year to collect art supplies for the Passport to the World Program. This program was created for students from 8-18 to learn about different countries and their cultures. 



## HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

The International District would like to remind everyone that Hurricane Season is upon us. We all need to be smart and plan ahead for all kinds of disasters: natural, man-made, technological and terrorist related. In Southeast Texas, however, the most likely disaster scenario is a Hurricane.

#### BEFORE THE HURRICANE

- Monitor local TV or AM 740 KTRH
- Check supplies; especially water
- ➡ Fuel Vehicles & Generators
- Cover Windows with Plywood
- Bring in all objects that could become missiles
- Take pictures of property & contents for insurance purposes

#### DON'T FORGET THE PETS!

Pet disaster kits should include: medications, first aid kits, sturdy leashes and collars, carriers to transport pets safely, current photos with owner or family members, food, potable water, litter/pan, muzzle, can opener, and toys.

Make a check list of necessary pre-hurricane preparations and review with your family. Review it again when there is a storm in the Gulf. Discuss evacuation plans with your family.

Check Radio 740 and local television media for updates on zones being evacuated.

Make sure your home insurance policy is current and remember that standard policies may not cover flood/ wind damage.
