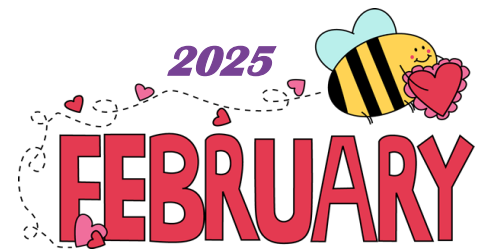

The "Mission of the Month" for February is the Souper Bowl of Caring. For over 30 years, the Souper Bowl of Caring has been driving grassroots efforts using the energy of the Big Game to illustrate the collective impact of tackling hunger locally.



Each year, churches, schools, and civic groups around the country join us, and host food and fundraising campaigns that benefit charities in their own neighborhoods.

Since 1990, close to \$200 million has been donated to local charities around the nation with over 305,000 unique groups participating.

Please help us in supporting this wonderful cause to help those in need. All money and food collected on February 9th will go to tackling hunger through the Fair Haven Food Pantry. Last year we collected 466 pounds of food and \$163. Let's see if we can top that in 2025!

# SBPC Cowboy Chili Dinner

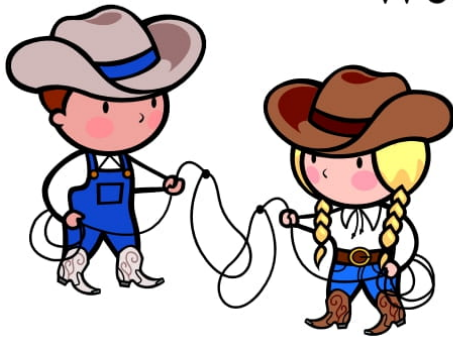
Once again we are having our “occasionally-annual”

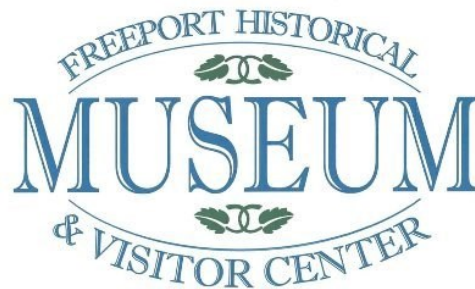

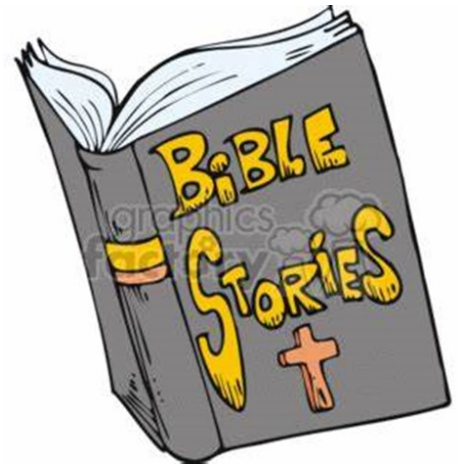

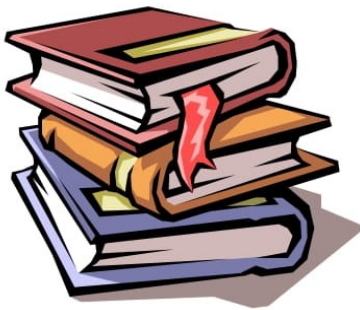
