From the desk of Pastor Savannah Goodman...

Dear Spring Branch Presbyterian,

Each year, Easter has unexpected elements that teach me new things about joy, love, and the power of surprise. When I was little, it was hunting for Easter eggs. My brother and I would run around shrieking for joy every time we found an Easter egg in our backyard (my parents were very patient with us!). As I have gotten older, my focus has shifted to relationships and the unexpected teachings that are a result of spending time with people. As I get to know people, I learn new things about joy, love, and the power of surprise that shape my faith and also me as an individual.

During this season of Lent, we have been exploring the theme of how God and Jesus work in unexpected ways. We live in a world that thrives on the predictable, the familiar, and the comfortable. But, God frequently disrupts our understanding with surprises — surprises that lead us to deeper faith, a greater trust, and a fuller sense of God's presence in our lives. Surprises that teach us new things about joy and love.

Jesus' ministry was full of unexpected moments — moments that upended the religious, social, and political norms of the time. He was not what the people expected. But it was precisely in these unexpected ways that God's bigger plan was made known — through love, humility, sacrificial service, joy, love, and surprise. This is the beauty of the unexpected Messiah: Jesus comes to us not in the ways we anticipate, but in the ways we need.

As we continue through this season of Lent, we are invited to embrace the unexpected, to trust in God's big plan, and to open our hearts to new possibilities. Let us follow the example of Jesus, the unexpected Messiah, and embrace joy and love. Let us prioritize relationships — with God, with one another, with ourselves, and with the world. And, let us never underestimate the power of surprises.

SBPC Weekend Hot Meals



I bet you have heard of *Meals on Wheels*. It is a national program that delivers nutritious meals to seniors who have difficulty accessing food due to mobility issues or other challenges. Did you know that *Meals on Wheels* does not deliver meals to these seniors on the weekend? But, SBPC does for about 30 seniors in the Spring Branch area on the 4th Saturday of the month. Lu Taylor takes the lead in this wonderful mission.

We have 2 routes; therefore, we usually need 4 volunteers to split the delivery of about 30 hot meals on the 4th Saturday of the month. The 2 groups pick up the delicious, hot lunches from Pappy's Restaurant at 11:00 AM at 12313 Katy Freeway. SBPC pays somewhere between \$4 and \$5 for each meal, with Pappy's contributing the remainder of their costs. The delivery is your donation, which takes about an hour from the time you pick up the lunches to completing the route. Lu Taylor sends you the route and instructions a few days before your time.

For those of you with kids, this is a great way to show them how they can help and serve people by doing something as simple as delivering a meal to them. It is a very rewarding experience for everyone and much appreciated by the receivers of the meals.






